## Notes on safe operation



**Read the operating instructions before commissioning the unit. For your own safety, follow the instructions and warnings in these operating instructions. Store the operating instructions near the EFOY fuel cell.**



### WARNING



The EFOY fuel cell is intended for operation in well-ventilated environments and requires sufficient incoming air that is free of exhaust gas. The device is to be protected against direct weather influences, especially moisture penetration. The device generates exhaust gases that must be ventilated to open air using the accompanying exhaust gas hose. Always ensure sufficient ventilation.



Do not open the EFOY fuel cell. Do not open fuel cartridges and do not refill them.



Transport in an upright position only.



Protect the EFOY fuel cell and fuel cartridges from heat and direct sunlight. Observe the temperature specifications for operation and storage in SECTION 2.3.3.



Store the EFOY fuel cell in a place protected from frost. For frost-free operation at temperatures under 3 °C, leave a full fuel cartridge and intact battery connected.



Do not smoke around the EFOY fuel cell or fuel cartridges. Keep sources of heat and ignition away from the device and fuel cartridges.



The EFOY fuel cells and empty or partially emptied fuel cartridges are not intended for use by persons (including children) with limited

physical, sensory or mental capacities or persons who lack experience and/or knowledge unless they are supervised by a person responsible for their safety or have received instructions from them on how the device is to be used. Children must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the device.

## 1 Safety

### 1.1 Explanation of signal words



#### **DANGER**

Indicates a hazard with a high degree of risk which, if not avoided, will result in death or serious injury.

► Pay attention to the danger warning.



#### **WARNING**

Indicates a hazard with a medium degree of risk which, if not avoided, can result in death or serious injury.

► Pay attention to the danger warning.



#### **CAUTION**

Indicates a hazard with a low degree of risk which, if not avoided, can result in minor or moderate injury.

► Pay attention to the danger warning.



#### **INFO**

Indicates an action which can result in damage.

► Pay attention to the information.



Includes further information and tips on using the EFOY fuel cell in an optimal way.

## 1.2 Safety instructions for the EFOY fuel cell



### DANGER

**Risk of electric shock!** The EFOY fuel cell is not waterproof. Penetrating water connecting with electricity creates a risk of injury.

- ▶ Ensure that no water can enter the EFOY fuel cell.
- ▶ Choose an area protected from exposure to water for installing the EFOY fuel cell.
- ▶ Do not use the EFOY fuel cell if any part of it has been submerged in water. A fuel cell which has been damaged by water is extremely dangerous. Attempting to use the EFOY fuel cell can lead to fire or explosion. Notify SFC Energy or your service partner immediately to have the EFOY fuel cell examined and the affected functional parts replaced.



### WARNING

Inadequate installation and attachment of the EFOY fuel cartridges and EFOY fuel cell creates a risk of injury.

- ▶ Attach the EFOY fuel cell and EFOY fuel cartridges in a safe and secure way.



### CAUTION

Unapproved parts can damage the EFOY fuel cell. This creates a risk of injury.

- ▶ Use only original accessories.

### Safety instructions for ventilation



### WARNING

Exhaust gases from the EFOY fuel cell may contain harmful compounds.

- ▶ Do not breathe in exhaust gases directly or for prolonged periods.
- ▶ Use only the accompanying exhaust gas hose.
- ▶ Using the exhaust hose, direct the exhaust gases from the installation area to the open air.

**WARNING**

Blocked or congested ventilation openings prevent the required air supply and removal.

- ▶ The EFOY fuel cell may only be operated in a well-ventilated environment.
- ▶ Ensure that the openings for the incoming and outgoing air are not blocked by any objects.
- ▶ Keep the environment around the EFOY fuel cell clean and free of gasoline, flammable substances and other ignitable vapors and liquids.

**Safety instructions for the electronics and battery****DANGER**

**Risk of fire!** Incorrectly laid or sized cables can cause a fire.

- ▶ Ensure that all connected lines have sufficient insulation and electric strength.
- ▶ Ensure that the contact points are protected from being touched.
- ▶ Do not install any bare metal lines or contacts.
- ▶ Allow only professional electricians to work on electrical systems.
- ▶ Use only the accompanying EFOY charging cable.
- ▶ The battery terminal which is not connected to the chassis is to be connected first. The other connection is to be made to the chassis at a distance from the battery and gasoline line.

**WARNING**

Insufficient ventilation of the batteries results in a risk of explosion.

- ▶ Avoid flames and sparks.
- ▶ While charging the battery, ensure sufficient ventilation.
- ▶ Follow the safety instructions of the battery manufacturer.

**WARNING**

Risk of fire!

- ▶ Non-rechargeable batteries may not be charged with the EFOY fuel cell.
- ▶ Use only battery types that correspond with the specifications.

### 1.3 Safety instructions for methanol

Safe and tested EFOY fuel cartridges contain methanol approved by SFC Energy AG. When the EFOY fuel cell and EFOY fuel cartridges are used properly, there is no risk of coming into contact with methanol.

**DANGER**

**Risk of fire!** Methanol is highly flammable. Escaping methanol vapors can cause a fire.

- ▶ Do not smoke while changing an EFOY fuel cartridge and keep all sources of ignition away.
- ▶ Keep the area around the EFOY fuel cell and fuel cartridge clean and free of gasoline and other sources of ignition.
- ▶ Protect the EFOY fuel cell and EFOY fuel cartridges from temperatures over 50 °C.

**DANGER**

**Risk of poisoning!** Breathing in, touching or swallowing methanol can cause poisoning.

- ▶ Do not breathe in exhaust gases directly or for prolonged periods.
- ▶ Do not touch leaked methanol. In small quantities, methanol evaporates without residue in a ventilated environment.
- ▶ Contact a doctor immediately in case of direct contact, an accident or if you are feeling unwell. Show the doctor the fuel cartridge label or methanol safety data sheet.

### 1.4.1 Declaration of conformity

EFOY fuel cells have been voluntarily submitted for testing by TÜV SÜD Industrie und Service GmbH for compliance with the basic requirements of DIN EN IEC 62282-5-100 (VDE 0130-5-100):2019-05/EN IEC 62282-5-100:2018 and labeled with the seal of approval for product safety.

### 1.4.3 Warranty

The warranty period begins with the purchase of a new EFOY fuel cell and only takes effect following registration. Retain the purchase receipt in a secure place. Warranty service is based on the warranty conditions of SFC Energy AG valid at the time of purchase for the respective country. Observe the warranty conditions accompanying the product or available at [www.efoy.com](http://www.efoy.com).

## 1.5 Proper use

EFOY fuel cells from the SFC Energy AG company are automatic charging devices for 12 V and 24 V lead batteries and lithium iron phosphate batteries (LiFePO<sub>4</sub>).

- Only batteries which comply with the specifications of the device (see [SECTION 2.3](#)) may be charged.
- Only EFOY fuel cells with intact, undamaged housings may be operated.
- Use only undamaged original EFOY fuel cartridges.



- **Permissible:** Parallel connection of EFOY fuel cells for increasing the charging current.
- **Not permissible:** Serial connection of EFOY fuel cells for increasing the voltage.
- EFOY fuel cells are not intended for use as an emergency supply of power for medical, life-sustaining or agricultural devices.

## 1.6 Transportation and disposal

### WARNING

**Risk of suffocation** from films and folding boxes.

The EFOY fuel cell is protected by packaging. All materials used are environmentally friendly and recyclable. Dispose of the packaging and EFOY fuel cell in an environmentally responsible way in accordance with the local regulations.

**Special waste:** Dispose of EFOY fuel cartridges as special waste.

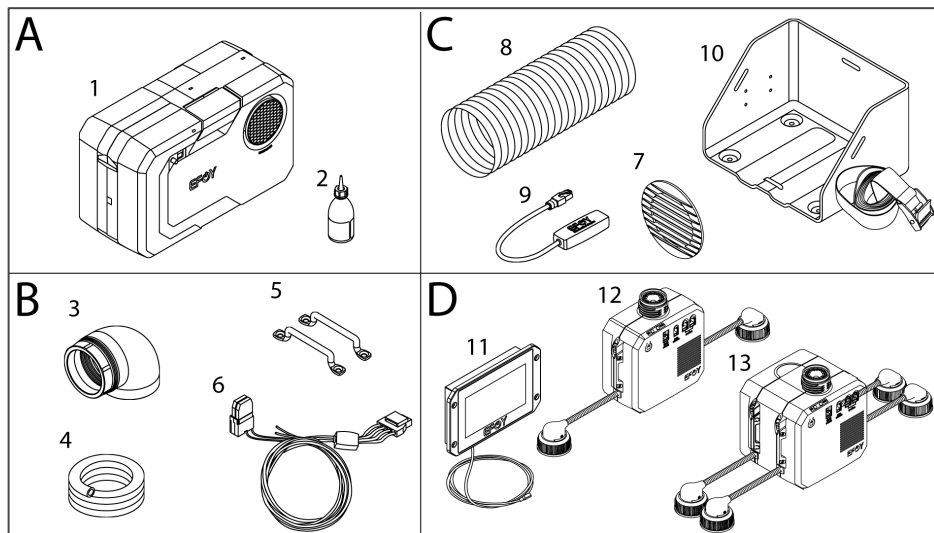

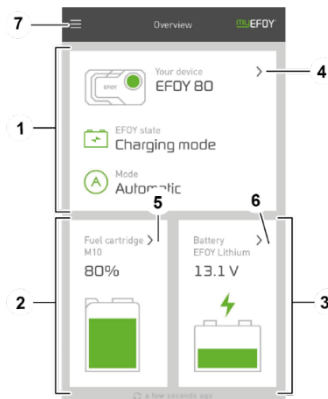

## 3.2 Using the operating panel

Button operation procedure: One brief press (less than 1 second) switches between the operating modes, and one long press (over 5 seconds) initiates a reset.



## 4 Commissioning the EFOY fuel cell

### Requirement:

The EFOY fuel cell and fuel cartridge are installed. Should this not be the case, refer to the steps for mounting, electrical connection and use of the EFOY fuel cell and fuel cartridge in the revision 10/2020 of the mounting instructions which you can download from [www.efoy.com](http://www.efoy.com).

### 4.1 Initial commissioning

During the initial commissioning, the following required and recommended settings must be made:

- ▶ Battery type (required)
- ▶ Battery capacity (required)
- ▶ Fuel cartridge configuration (recommended)
- ▶ Deactivation of transportation protection (Required in order to start operation. If only settings are to be made, transportation protection can remain active.)

#### 4.1.1 Configuring a battery

When a new battery is connected, it must be configured. Select the battery type (lead or lithium iron phosphate) and the voltage (12 V or 24 V).



#### CAUTION

Only lithium batteries of type “LiFePO4” with a rated voltage of 12.8 V or 25.6 V and a built-in battery management system (BMS) can be recharged.

- ▶ Observe the charging information from the battery manufacturer.

#### 4.1.2 Configuring the fuel cartridge

For an accurate indication of the fuel cartridge fill level, the connected fuel cartridge type must be selected.

The fill level of the fuel cartridge can be adjusted manually if a partially filled fuel cartridge is connected.

#### 4.1.3 Deactivating transportation protection

The EFOY fuel cell is delivered with transportation protection activated.

This condition prevents frost damage during transportation, among other things.

If only settings are to be made to the device, transportation protection can remain activated.

To use the EFOY fuel cell, transportation protection must be deactivated using the EFOY app or the operating panel.

## 4.2 Operation

The EFOY fuel cell indicates its status by way of the status LED on the device (see [SECTION 2.2, ITEM 11](#)). A detailed overview of the LED color codes can be found in [SECTION 8](#).

The EFOY fuel cell can be operated in two different operating modes:

- Automatic (see [SECTION 4.2.1](#)).
- Sleep (see [SECTION 4.2.2](#)).



For optimum operation of the EFOY fuel cell, we recommend always using the **Automatic** operating mode.

The following functions can be carried out in both operating modes:

- Begin charging (see [SECTION 4.2.3](#)).
- Restart (see [SECTION 4.2.4](#)).
- Reset to the factory defaults (see [SECTION 4.2.6](#)).

For information on changing the operating mode using the button (see [SECTION 2.2, NUMBER 6](#)), refer to the overview in [SECTION 3.3](#).

### 4.2.1 Automatic operating mode

Following the initial configuration and deactivation of transportation protection, the device is in Automatic mode. The LED flashes green.

The EFOY fuel cell monitors the battery voltage by itself.

If the battery voltage drops below the switch-on voltage or switch-on threshold (see [SECTION 2.3](#)), the EFOY fuel cell switches on automatically.

The battery is charged until the switch-off voltage or switch-off threshold is reached (see [SECTION 2.3](#)). The EFOY fuel cell then switches off. The switch-off duration depends on the switch-off current and absorption time (see [SECTION 9](#)).



In normal operation, the EFOY fuel cell interrupts current generation for approx. 30 seconds several times per hour. A charging current of 0.0 A is displayed here.

For optimum care of the battery, the EFOY fuel cell does not cut off the charging current abruptly when it switches off. The EFOY fuel cell continues charging up to the maximum absorption time (see [SECTION 2.3](#)) at a reduced current. The duration of recharging depends on the battery voltage and whether or not the switch-off current is reached. You can set the charging duration manually.

## 4.2.2 Sleep operating mode

In the **Sleep** operating mode, the battery is no longer charged automatically. Only battery protection and antifreeze are still maintained. A sufficiently full fuel cartridge and battery must be connected for this purpose.

This mode can be used, for example, if the battery will not be used for a longer period of time or charging must be interrupted manually.

In the **Sleep** operating mode, the LED is off.



If you switch the EFOY fuel cell to Sleep mode before the minimum charging duration has been reached (see [SECTION 2.3](#)), it continues running for the corresponding amount of time until the charging cycle is complete. Leave the fuel cartridge and battery connected during the shutdown procedure.

## 4.2.3 Starting the charging process

### Requirement

The battery voltage is below the maximum voltage at which the fuel cell can start (see [SECTION 2.3](#)).

The EFOY fuel cell charges the battery until the switch-off voltage is reached (see [SECTION 2.3](#)). The EFOY fuel cell then switches off automatically and remains in the **Automatic** operating mode, regardless of the previous operating mode. During the charging process, the LED continuously lights up green.



The EFOY fuel cell is in a start-up phase in which the device is warming up when charging begins. Once the start-up phase is complete, the EFOY fuel cell reaches its full output power level.

## 4.2.4 Ending the charging process

If you would like to stop charging, switch the EFOY fuel cell to the **Sleep** operating mode. If you would like the device to then start up again automatically, it must be switched back to the **Automatic** operating mode.

### 4.2.5 Restarting the EFOY fuel cell

The **Reset** function enables you to restart the EFOY fuel cell. The reset can occur either in the Automatic operating mode or in the Sleep operating mode. For this purpose, press and hold the button (see [SECTION 2.2, NUMBER 6](#)) for 5–10 seconds (see [SECTION 3.3](#))

### 4.2.6 Resetting the EFOY fuel cell to the factory defaults

Using a paper clip, push the button in the opening on the protective cap retainer for 10 seconds (see [SECTION 2.2, NUMBER 5](#)).

By resetting the factory defaults, the following settings are reset:

- ▶ Battery type
- ▶ Battery capacity
- ▶ Fuel cartridge configuration
- ▶ Charge cycle monitor (average duration and the duration of the previous cycle)
- ▶ Ethernet configuration (manually configured IP, IP mask, gateway address and DHCP client is enabled)

## 5 Maintaining and caring for the EFOY fuel cell



Under normal usage conditions, the EFOY fuel cell is maintenance free. The EFOY fuel cell does not contain any parts which you yourself can maintain or repair. Do not open the EFOY fuel cell.

### 5.1 Changing the fuel cartridge



The fuel cartridge can be changed while the device is running. Each fuel cartridge can only be used once; they cannot be refilled. Do not change the EFOY fuel cartridge until it is completely empty.

The shelf life of EFOY fuel cartridges is limited. Pay attention to the expiration date on the back of the EFOY fuel cartridge: MM/YYYY.

If the fuel cartridge is empty, the LED on the device will light up (see [SECTION 3.3](#) and [SECTION 8](#)).

**Fuel cartridge empty** appears in the EFOY app and on the operating panel.



#### INFO

Contamination or foreign particles in commercially available methanol will damage the EFOY fuel cell.

- ▶ Use only original EFOY fuel cartridges approved by SFC Energy AG.
- ▶ Check the fuel cartridge connection for proper functioning on a regular basis.

Only use the EFOY fuel cartridge in an upright position during operation.

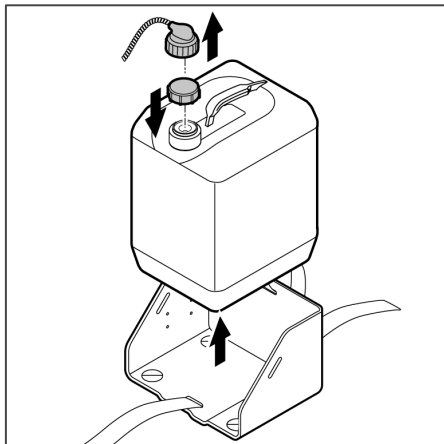
Exception: fuel cartridge M28. If using the EFOY fuel cartridge without a fuel cartridge holder, ensure that it is secured properly.



Store the sealing cap of the EFOY fuel cartridge in a safe place so that you can reseal the EFOY fuel cartridge when you remove it.

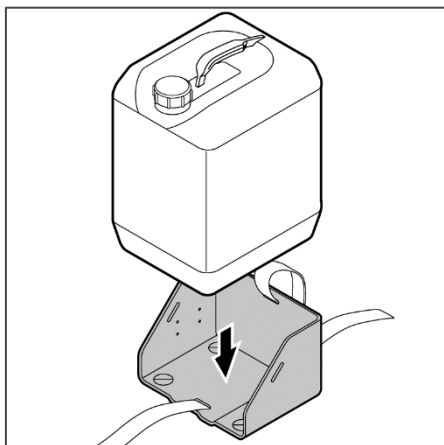


### 5.1.1 Removing the fuel cartridge



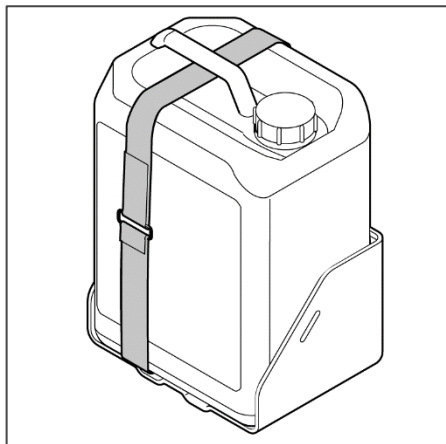
- ▶ Unscrew the fuel cartridge connection from the empty fuel cartridge.
- ▶ Seal the fuel cartridge tight using the sealing cap.
- ▶ Open the belt.
- ▶ Remove the fuel cartridge.

### 5.1.2 Connecting an M5/M10 fuel cartridge



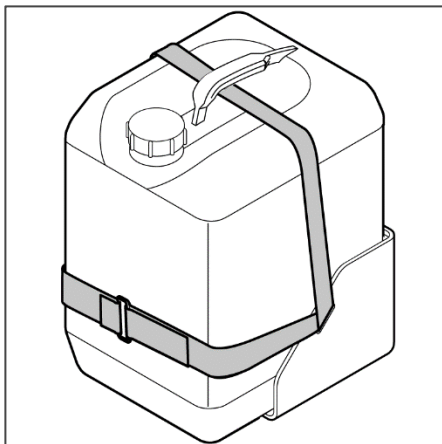
#### **M5 and M10 fuel cartridge:**

- ▶ Insert a sealed original EFOY fuel cartridge into the fuel cartridge holder with the connection facing upwards.



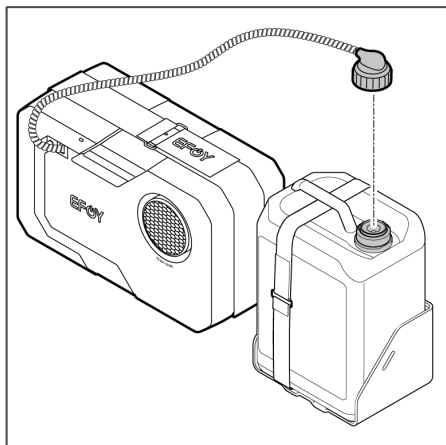
## M5 fuel cartridge:

- ▶ Secure the belt of the fuel cartridge holder **vertically**.
- ▶ Remove the sealing cap.



## M10 fuel cartridge:

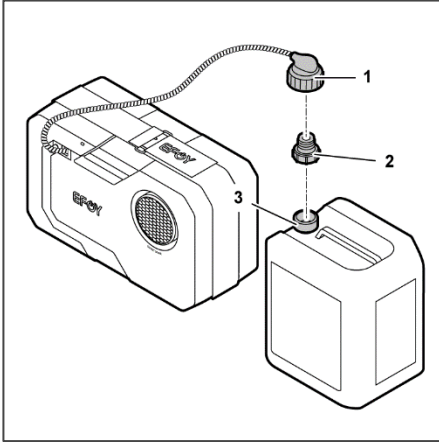
- ▶ Secure the belt of the fuel cartridge holder **across the side**.
- ▶ Remove the sealing cap.



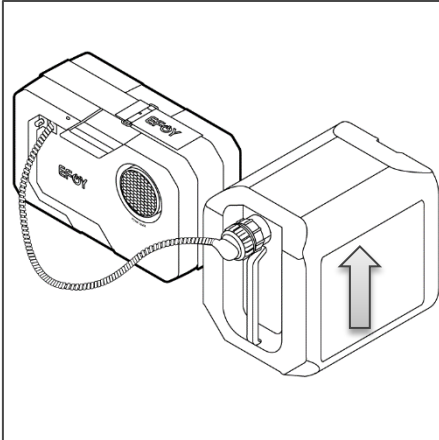
- ▶ Screw the fuel cartridge connection onto the EFOY fuel cartridge.

## 5.1.3 Connecting an M28 fuel cartridge

An M28 adapter is required for connection. The M28 fuel cartridge is not suitable for use in vehicles.



- ▶ Remove the sealing cap of the EFOY M28 fuel cartridge.
- ▶ Screw the M28 adapter (2) onto the EFOY M28 fuel cartridge (3).
- ▶ Screw the fuel cartridge connection (1) onto the M28 adapter (2).



The EFOY M28 fuel cartridge can also be used in a horizontal position. The safety valve and fuel cartridge connector must always be on the top side of the fuel cartridge when lying on its side.



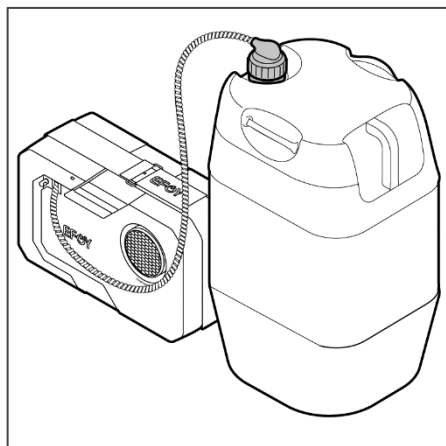
## CAUTION

If the fuel cartridge is inserted incorrectly, methanol can leak out.

- ▶ If the M28 fuel cartridge is used in a horizontal position, the safety valve and fuel cartridge connector must always be on the top side of the fuel cartridge when lying on it's side.

### 5.1.4 Connecting the MT60 methanol tank

The **MT60** is not suitable for use in vehicles.



- ▶ Remove the sealing cap.
- ▶ Screw the fuel cartridge connection onto the EFOY methanol tank.

#### **MT60 tank:**

The MT60 tank must be installed and secured upright in stationary and mobile applications.

Installation must be inspected and approved for safety.

## 5.2 Cleaning the EFOY fuel cell



## WARNING

Risk of injury from electric shock.

- ▶ Do not allow moisture to penetrate the EFOY fuel cell.

- ▶ Switch off the EFOY fuel cell (see [SECTION 4.2.4](#)).
- ▶ Unplug the charging cable (see [SECTION 7.1](#)).
- ▶ Slightly moisten a soft cloth with a mild cleaning agent.
- ▶ Clean the EFOY fuel cell with the cloth.
- ▶ Reconnect the charging cable.

### 5.3 Changing the battery or working on the battery

- ▶ Switch off the EFOY fuel cell (see [SECTION 4.2.4](#)).
- ▶ Unplug the charging cable (see [SECTION 7.1](#)).
- ▶ Do not reconnect the charging cable until you have changed the battery or are finished working on the battery.
- ▶ Set the new battery type using the EFOY app or the operating device.

### 5.4 Firmware update

When the EFOY fuel cell is connected to a router with an Internet connection, it searches for available firmware updates automatically. If a new update is available, the update is automatically saved in the EFOY fuel cell. The update itself can only be carried out if charging is not in progress.



During the update process, ensure that the EFOY fuel cell is connected to the battery and that there is an Internet connection.

The firmware update can last several minutes.

Check for firmware updates at least once a year with your sales partner, using the EFOY hotline or at [www.efoy.com](http://www.efoy.com).

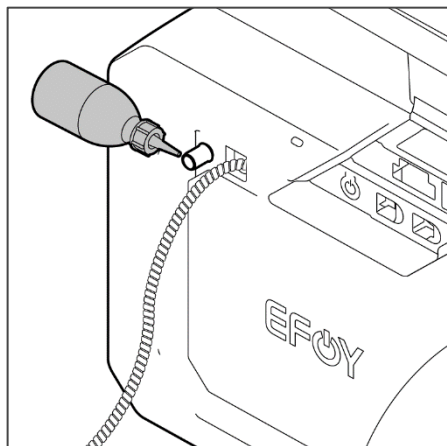
## 5.5 Refilling EFOY service fluid

If the **Please refill service fluid** message appears in the operating panel or EFOY app, please follow the instructions.

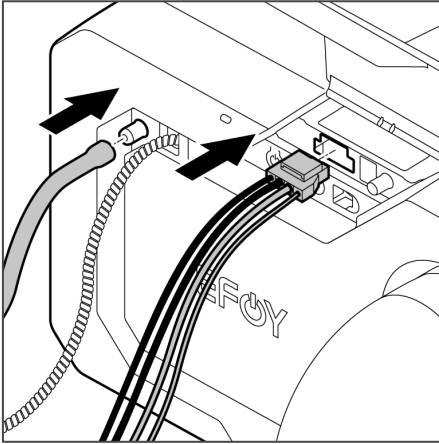


Use only original EFOY service fluid. Add a bottle of EFOY service fluid as needed. Do not add a second bottle of EFOY service fluid unless the message appears again. A bottle is only intended for one use.

- ▶ Switch off the EFOY fuel cell (see [SECTION 4.2.4](#)).
- ▶ Unplug the charging cable (see [SECTION 7.1](#)).
- ▶ Cut off the tip of the bottle with a clean pair of scissors.



- ▶ Disconnect the exhaust gas hose. Ensure that dirt or foreign bodies do not enter the filling hole.
- ▶ Guide the tip of the bottle into the exhaust gas opening.
- ▶ Slowly squeeze the entire contents into the hole.
- ▶ If EFOY service fluid spills over, wipe it up with a cloth.



- ▶ Reattach the exhaust gas hose.
- ▶ Reattach the charging cable. The EFOY is now in Automatic mode once again.
- ▶ Obtain a new bottle of EFOY service fluid from your specialist dealer.

## 6 Remedying malfunctions

### 6.1 Malfunctions indicated by messages

In case of interruptions and malfunctions, the status LED will flash or light up (see [SECTION 8](#)) and a message appears in the EFOY app and on the operating panel. There you will find instructions on how you can remedy the interruption/malfunction.

### 6.2 Malfunctions not indicated by messages

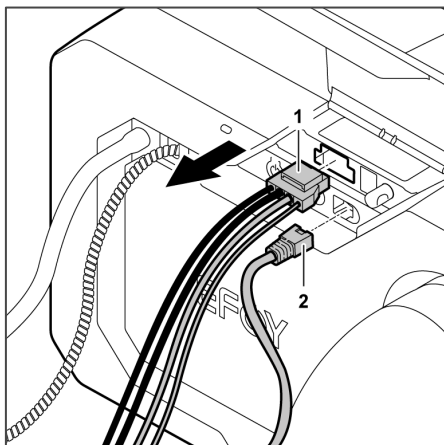

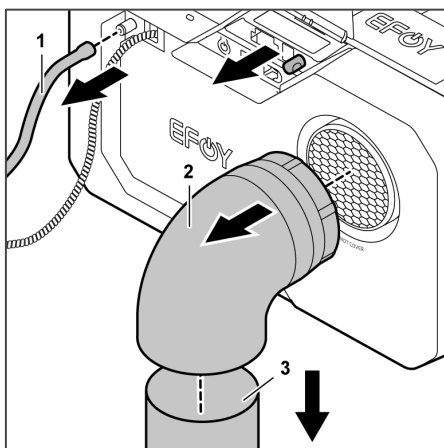
## 7 Shutting down and storing the EFOY fuel cell

### 7.1 Shutting down the EFOY fuel cell

- ▶ Switch off the EFOY fuel cell (see [SECTION 4.2.4](#)).
- ▶ Remove the EFOY fuel cartridge.



- ▶ Unplug the charging cable (1).
- ▶ Unplug the cable (2) for the operating panel or Bluetooth adapter.



- ▶ Disconnect the exhaust gas hose (1) and seal the exhaust gas opening with the protective cap. (See [SECTION 2.2](#))
- ▶ Disconnect the exhaust heat elbow (2) and the exhaust heat tube (3).
- ▶ Loosen the belt.
- ▶ Remove the EFOY fuel cell from the installation space.

### 7.2 Storing the EFOY fuel cell

- ▶ Always carry out the transportation protection procedure prior to storing the EFOY fuel cell to prevent it from freezing (see [SECTION 7.3](#)).

- ▶ The EFOY fuel cell may only be stored upright in a suitable box, e.g. the box it came in.
- ▶ Store the EFOY fuel cell in a cool and well-ventilated place which is over 1 °C.



### INFO

If the EFOY fuel cell is exposed to temperatures below 1 °C without the battery connected and without a sufficiently filled EFOY fuel cartridge, there is a risk of frost damage.

- ▶ Allow the EFOY fuel cell to defrost for approx. 24 hours at room temperature before operating it.













## 7.3 Activating transportation protection/carrying out the transportation protection procedure




- ▶ **Using the EFOY app/operating device:** See fuel cell detail page. (See [SECTION 3.1](#))
- ▶ Follow the instructions.

The transportation protection procedure and successful activation of transportation protection are indicated by the LED (see [SECTION 8](#)).

## 9 Glossary

<b>Absorption time</b>	<b>Automatic operating mode:</b> If the switch-off voltage has been reached, but the switch-off current is not reached within the absorption time, the EFOY fuel cell switches off when the absorption time is reached.
<b>Antifreeze (EFOY state)</b>	The EFOY fuel cell is in operation in order to warm itself. The battery is charged if necessary. Antifreeze switches on automatically as soon as the temperature drops below +3 °C. For a five-month winter period in Central Europe, the EFOY fuel cell requires about 10 liters of methanol for antifreeze.
<b>Automatic (operating mode)</b>	The EFOY fuel cell switches on automatically when the battery voltage falls below the switch-on voltage (or switch-on threshold). The EFOY fuel cell charges the battery until the switch-off voltage (or switch-off threshold) is reached and then switches off.
<b>Battery protection (EFOY status)</b>	Battery protection is activated automatically if the battery voltage drops below the voltage for battery protection, even if the EFOY fuel cell is in Sleep mode (see <a href="#">SECTION 2.3</a> ).
<b>Charge now</b>	<b>Automatic and Off operating modes:</b> If the battery voltage is below the max. "charge now" voltage, the EFOY fuel cell can be switched on regardless of the operating mode. The EFOY fuel cell charges the battery until the switch-off voltage is reached. The fuel cell is then in the Automatic operating mode.
<b>Charging (EFOY state)</b>	The EFOY fuel cell charges the battery.
<b>EFOY state</b>	The EFOY state is the respective phase in which the EFOY fuel cell is currently found. The operating phases are: charging, standby, off, shutdown procedure, battery protection, antifreeze, transportation protection, malfunction and information.
<b>Malfunction (EFOY state)</b>	There is a malfunction, and the corresponding information is displayed.
<b>Max. charging duration</b>	If the switch-off voltage is not reached within the max. charging duration, the EFOY fuel cell switches off.
<b>Min. charging duration</b>	The EFOY fuel cell calculates the average duration of a charging cycle. If the value drops below the set value, this indicates a defective battery or a battery which is too old or too small. It could also indicate incorrectly set battery parameters. Persistently short charging cycles can cause damage to the EFOY fuel cell or battery.

<b>Mode</b>	The operating mode determines the behavior of the EFOY fuel cell. There are two operating modes: Automatic and Sleep. The recommended operating mode is Automatic.
<b>Off (EFOY status)</b>	<b>Off operating mode:</b> The switch-on voltage (switch-on threshold) is not taken into account. To protect the fuel cell and battery, antifreeze and battery protection are activated if necessary.
<b>Shutdown procedure (EFOY state)</b>	<b>Off operating mode:</b> The EFOY fuel cell has been switched to the Off operating mode. Charging is stopped. The switch-off duration depends on the switch-off current and absorption time.
<b>Sleep (operating mode)</b>	The EFOY fuel cell is switched off. The switch-on voltage is not taken into account. To protect the fuel cell and battery, antifreeze and battery protection are activated if necessary. If you switch the EFOY fuel cell to Sleep mode before the minimum charging duration has been reached (see <a href="#">SECTION 2.3</a> ), it continues running for the corresponding amount of time until the charging cycle is complete. Leave the fuel cartridge and battery connected during the shutdown procedure.
<b>Standby (EFOY state)</b>	<b>Automatic operating mode:</b> The EFOY fuel cell is in Standby mode and monitors the battery voltage or charge level. The battery is sufficiently charged.
<b>Start phase (EFOY state)</b>	<b>Automatic and Off operating modes:</b> The EFOY fuel cell is in a start-up phase in which the device is warming up when charging begins. Once the start-up phase is complete, the EFOY fuel cell reaches its full output power level.
<b>Switch-off current</b>	<b>Automatic operating mode:</b> When the switch-off voltage is reached, the charging current is reduced. When the charging current drops below the set switch-off current, the EFOY fuel cell switches off. The switch-off duration depends on the absorption time, in addition to the switch-off current.
<b>Switch-off threshold</b>	<b>Automatic operating mode:</b> <b>Only pertains to smart batteries (see “Switch-off voltage” for standard batteries).</b> The EFOY fuel cell charges the battery until the charge level reaches the maximum charge level and then switches off (see <a href="#">SECTION 2.3</a> ).
<b>Switch-off voltage</b>	<b>Automatic operating mode:</b> The EFOY fuel cell charges the battery until the battery voltage reaches the switch-off voltage and then switches off (see <a href="#">SECTION 2.3</a> ). The switch-off duration depends on the switch-off current and absorption time.
<b>Switch-on delay</b>	<b>Automatic operating mode:</b>

If the battery voltage drops below the switch-on voltage for the duration of the switch-on delay, the EFOY fuel cells start automatically.

## Switch-on threshold

### **Automatic operating mode:**

**Only pertains to smart batteries (see “Switch-on voltage” for standard batteries).**

The EFOY fuel cell switches on automatically if the charge level drops below the maximum discharge level (see [SECTION 2.3](#)).

## Switch-on voltage

### **Automatic operating mode:**

The EFOY fuel cell switches on automatically when the battery voltage falls below the switch-on voltage (or switch-on threshold) (see [SECTION 2.3](#)). The switch-on delay is taken into account here.

## Transportation protection (EFOY state)

The EFOY fuel cell is delivered with transportation protection activated. To protect against freezing, there is no water in any critical components. Settings for the battery and fuel cartridge can be made. Transportation protection must be deactivated in order to operate the unit.

## Transportation protection procedure

To activate transportation protection, water must be removed from critical components of the EFOY. This occurs as part of the transportation protection procedure. Follow the instructions on the operating panel or app. If the transportation protection procedure has been completed successfully, the EFOY fuel cell is in the transportation protection operating phase.
